Associate Program (AP) Trainee - Job Description

The AP Trainee position is a career path opportunity in which AP participants will be introduced to the BBVA culture and management style and will receive an overview and orientation training for the 3 primary lines of business: Retail, Commercial, and Wealth Management. The first year will be divided into two phases:

Phase One: AP participants will be required to attend training sessions, participate in group projects and participate in assessments to measure aptitude and interest in the 3 lines of business.

Phase Two: Participants will be placed in Line-of-Business-specific "tracks" based on participant interest and open slots available for those tracks. Participants will continue attending training sessions, and will be given more hands-on experience by working with mentors for their chosen track.

Additional Tasks during Phase Two:

- Shadow mentor in client-facing opportunities
- As the AP Trainee gains experience, they will be empowered to start direct interactions with clients (with mentor-shadowing)
- o Identify referral opportunities for appropriate business partners
- Understand strategic partner sales opportunities (job shadowing with those business partners)
- Other duties and special projects as assigned

At the end of Phase Two, participants will be placed in junior-level management positions within our lines of business. Participants will be placed in locations within the BBVA Compass footprint.
