Announcing the 2017 WHCLIST Award

The White House Conference on Library and Information Services Taskforce (*WHCLIST*) and the ALA Washington Office are calling for nominations for the 2017 *WHCLIST* Award. This award is granted to a non-librarian participant in National Library Legislative Day (NLLD). The winner receives a stipend of \$300 and two free nights at the Liaison Hotel. This year, NLLD will be held on May 1-2 in Washington, D.C. To qualify for the award, applicants should be a library supporter (trustee, friend, general supporter) and not a professional librarian, and first-time attendee of NLLD.

Application materials must be turned in no later than April 3, 2017. To apply for the *WHCLIST* award, please submit a completed NLLD registration form; a letter explaining why you should receive the award; and a letter of reference from a library director, school librarian, library board chair, Friends group chair, or other library representative to:
