Announcing the 2017 WHCLIST Award

The White House Conference on Library and Information Services Taskforce (WHCLIST) and the ALA Washington Office are calling for nominations for the 2017 WHCLIST Award. This award is granted to a non-librarian participant in National Library Legislative Day (NLLD). The winner receives a stipend of \$300 and two free nights at the Liaison Hotel. This year, NLLD will be held on May 1-2 in Washington, D.C. To qualify for the award, applicants should be a library supporter (trustee, friend, general supporter) and not a professional librarian, and first-time attendee of NLLD.

Application materials must be turned in no later than April 3, 2017.
